

Software Features




Functional Progress Note

Provides objective return-to-work data during the episode of outpatient rehabilitation following a 15 to 30-minute functional re-evaluation.



Functional Discharge Summary

Determines if your patient should be discharged and returned to work or should enter your work hardening/work conditioning program.



Work Conditioning Evaluation

Report shows you the exact percentage of return-to-work ability following the evaluation and decides the length of stay based on work hardening research.
